Idaho's premier piano trio, Trebelle, is presenting a concert of music celebrating spring for the 2024 spring concert season. The presentation of their program Scenes of Green will be presented on Friday, April 12th at 7:00pm, at Trinity United Methodist Church, 237 N. Water Ave. in Idaho Falls.

Suggested donation is \$20 per person, or \$10 for seniors and students.



Trebelle is an acclaimed piano trio formed in 2012 by pianist Robyn Wells, violinist Jennifer Dunn, and cellist Heidi Nagel.

They have performed at the Second City Chamber Series (Tacoma, WA), the Caldwell Fine Arts Series (Caldwell, ID), A Piano Celebration (College of Southern Idaho/Twin Falls), Second Sunday Sounds at Six (McCall, ID), and the Salt River Arts Society Series (Afton, WY.)

The trio was a featured performer at the Idaho Federation of Music Clubs State Convention in 2023, and performed the Beethoven Triple Concerto with Serenata Orchestra in 2019.

Known for their highly imaginative and creative programs, the trio performs biannual tours throughout the Intermountain West and Northwest, and has recorded two CDs.

This spring's program is inspired by spring, youth, and the melodies of Ireland. Johannes Brahms' first piano trio is featured, along with Frank Martin's Trio on Popular Irish Melodies. Other highlights include music by Elena Kats-Chernin, Rick Sowash, Astor Piazzolla, and the Taiwanese folk song Spring Breezes.

- 2. Chesbro Music Scholarship: one scholarship, up to \$1,000, for those pursuing a college major or minor in music.


The applicants should be active member/participant of Trinity United Methodist Church or St Paul's United Methodist Church.

Homeless Services

In February there were 125 homeless services supplied in the 17 days we were open. This represented services to 36 unique people. The services provided included 100 showers, 22 loads of laundry, and 5 requests for supplies. The supplies included non-skid shoes, ramen noodles, mac & cheese, socks, and underwear. The clients ranged in age from 14 to 73 with an average age of 49. Time in the church varied from 1 min. to 133 minutes with an average of 37 minutes. Most were returning clients, with 4 new clients. 53% have cellphones and 78% have valid ID.

We are updating our Sunday morning fellowship schedule.


